

# **Index to the Villages found on the map of Galicia as drawn by Rudolf Unterschutz with Parish Information**

Numerous versions of the map of Galicia (Galizien) drawn by Rudolf Unterschutz exist; I have seen four and there may be more. Some versions show the subsidiary villages (Tochtersiedlung) outside of Galicia, others do not.

This index was put together from three versions of the map. One, available online from Philip Semanchuk, shows only the larger cities outside of Galicia; another that is distributed by Betty Wray, the editor of the Galizien German Descendants Society newsletter, shows subsidiary villages all around Galicia; and the final version of the map used, obtained from Kathy Enders of the GGDS, shows a few additional villages to the north of Galicia, but very few of those found south of the province. Depending upon which version of the map you have, you may not find all of the villages listed in the index.

Also given is the legend from Philip Semanchuk's version of the map in both the original German and roughly translated into English. The German word "eingegangene" was difficult to render in English, but as used it appears to denote a village that has declined or shrunk over the years, perhaps losing its German character.

The spellings of village names within the border of Galicia were checked against the *Genealogical Gazetteer of Galicia* published by Brian Lenius. I do not have a good source to check the names of the subsidiary villages, so they are as best as I could read them from the maps. Any spelling errors are mine, and although umlauts were used, Polish characters were not.

Another very useful index to the villages on the map was done by Herr Oskar Wolf, but the copy I have has a few minor problems. Some of the villages shown on the map are not listed (such as Dolina), other villages that are listed are not found on the map (such as Sniatyn), and many of the subsidiary villages are not given. Herr Wolf's index does contain a wealth of information on when the village was founded, the primary religion of the inhabitants, the equivalent Ukrainian name of the village, what administrative district it was in, and the number of inhabitants in 1934, so despite its minor problems, it is well worth having. Herr Wolf has given his permission to the GGDS to distribute his index and it can be found on the GGDS web site, below.

For this update of the index, I've added parish information for many of the villages. I've concentrated on the Evangelical parishes, but some information is included for Roman Catholic parishes (prefaced with RC:) with a high concentration of Germans (Königsau, Felizienthal, and Machliniec), and there is some information about the Mennonites (prefaced with Men:) in and around Einsiedel. Any corrections to what I've listed, or any additions based on your research experience would be welcome. My email address can be found in the members' database.

Five sources were used. The first was the entries for the parishes in the Family History Library catalog of microfilms. The entry for a given parish frequently contains references to surrounding villages that were served by that parish. These entries are noted in the tables with a 1 in parentheses.

The second source was Brian J. Lenius' *Genealogical Gazetteer of Galicia*. It has an extensive listing of the villages in Galicia along with their Roman Catholic, Greek Catholic, Evangelical, Mennonite, Jewish, and other centers of worship. If you're looking for more definitive information on the villages and their parishes, I can highly recommend Brian's book. These entries are noted in the tables with a 2 in parentheses.

The third source was a map of the parish locations and surrounding villages found in the book *Heimat Galizien im Bild*. A note on the map states that the parishes in Königsberg, Josefsberg and Baginsberg-Kolomea were Reformed parishes, and all the others were Lutheran. As with the list discussed next, it showed a parish for Hohenbach, but none for Reichsheim, while the FHL has an entry for Reichsheim, but none for Hohenbach. These entries are noted in the tables with a 3 in parentheses.

The fourth source was a list of the parishes that I found on the web site of the Society for German Genealogy in Eastern Europe (SGGEE.org). It contained a list of the parishes in Galicia, along with lists for other areas where Germans had settled, and gave the following twenty-four parishes as of 1939:

Bandrow, Biala, Brigidau, Dornfeld, Gelsendorf, Hartfeld, Hohenbach, Jaroslaw, Josefsberg, Jozefow, Kolomyja (Kolomea), Königsberg, Krakow, Lwow (Lemberg), Neu-Gawlow, Nowy Sacz (Neu Sandez), Ranischau, Reichau, Stadlo, Stanislawow (Stanislau), Stryj, Ugartsthal, Unterwalden, and Zaleszczyki.

The parishes in the list are the same as those found on the map, and thus were not referenced separately. The document was here as of March, 2007, but may no longer be available:

The fifth source was an article in the GGD newsletter #36, Oct. 2003, which was used to identify some of the villages belonging to the Roman Catholic parish in Felizienthal.

**A number of interesting anomalies cropped up while putting together this index.**

**As noted above, the FHL shows no entry for Hohenbach but does for Reichsheim, and Brian's gazetteer gives Reichsheim as the parish for Hohenbach, but both the list from the SGGEE and the parish map give Hohenbach as the parish and not Reichsheim.**

**The Mennonite entries given by the FHL for Einsiedel are associated, for the most part, with Kiernica-Lemberg in Brian's gazetteer.**

**It would appear that early in the history of Galicia Gelsendorf was the primary parish for Germans living in Stryj, but during the 1890's they formed their own parish and began keeping their own records. So when researching that area it would be prudent to check both parishes and perhaps Brigidau as well. Because of the change-over, I've listed some of the entries as Gelsendorf, Stryj.**

**The FHL has separate entries for both Augustdorf and Konstantynowka, but the parish map shows them both as belonging to the Baginsberg-Kolomea parish, so be wary when researching in that area. This caution extends to other villages and towns in that general area; while the FHL shows records for Stanislau, I've found some entries for Germans from there in the Ugartsthal parish records and the gazetteer gives Ugartsthal as the parish for Stanislau.**

**The FHL has an entry for a Reformed church in Ugartsberg, but the parish map shows that village as belonging to the Josefsberg parish.**

**The Unterschutz map shows a village named Sitauerowka, but what appears to be the same village is listed by Brian Lenius as Sitanerowka, near Ladzkie Szlacheckie, and it appears as Sitanerowka in the Austrian Empire military maps that you can find via the GGDS web page.**

**The FHL has an entry for the Makowa Kolonia, and the parish map shows the village by that name. The Unterschutz map, however, appears to have the village mislabeled as Mawa Kolonia. The gazetteer lists the parish as Bandrow.**

**The Gelsendorf, Stryj, and Brigidau area can also be problematic. I've found entries for people living in villages south of Stryj entered in the Gelsendorf parish records after the Stryj parish was formed. It was probably a case of people going back to their home parish for events like baptisms, marriages, and burials.**

**For villages for which I was unable to find a definite parish reference, my advice would be to see if there is a nearby village for which a parish is given and see if it makes sense that your village of interest would also belong to that parish. In most cases you should be able to narrow it down fairly quickly.**
